- Comply with the applicable national legal regulations in force regarding Occupational Health and Safety.
- Establish a continuous improvement of actions for the Occupational Health and Safety Management System focused on protecting workers.











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- Promote safe and healthy work environments for direct employees, contractors, and subcontractors.
- Implement programs that drive a culture of prevention and self-care, intervention in work conditions that may cause accidents or work-related illnesses, waiver control, and preparation for emergencies.
- Delegate the responsibility of all employees, contractors, and subcontractors, to comply with the safety standards and procedures, in order to deliver a safe and productive work.
- It will be the responsibility of all the personnel of OPAIN S.A., contractors and subcontractors, to timely notify any dangerous conditions that may generate an accident, incident, or illness of any occupational nature.
